Government have examined the matter in detail and are pleased to accord Administrative sanction for the plan scheme "Decision support system for spatial planning and empowering local self governments in spatial governance" of Kerala State Remote Sensing and Environment Centre for the FY 2023-24 at a total cost of Rs.342 lakh (Three Crore Forty Two Lakh only) by meeting the expenditure from the Head of Account 2402-00-001-94-00-35-0-P-V and subject to the following general conditions where ever applicable.
- i) All rules, formalities and procedures shall be strictly followed for the implementation of the scheme. The norms of financial propriety shall be adhered to.
- ii) The expenditure would be met only from the provision available under the appropriate head of account.
- iii) The fund release will be based on actual requirement, and the fund released should not be parked in banks.
- iv) Store Purchase Rules shall be strictly adhered to for all kinds of purchases.
- v) Tender/e-tender and other stipulated formalities shall be followed wherever necessary.
- vi) Post creation is not admissible under the scheme.
- vii)The Head of Departments shall monitor the implementation of the scheme and ensure that the implementation is as per the existing procedures, rules and regulations.
- viii) The implementation agencies/ Departments also should prepare an

implementation schedule to complete the project in time and send regular progress report on financial and physical progress on a quarterly basis.

ix) The Director should hold monitoring meetings to review the progress and send report to Government regarding the progress of

implementation of the approved scheme.

x) HODs of line departments concerned shall sign an MoU with the concerned implementing agencies of the scheme before releasing the funds. It should also be ensured that the Utilization Certificates pertain to all schemes are submitted by the agencies in time.

xi) Appointment / continuance of contract / daily waged employees and enhancement of TA in case of temporary staff should be made only

with the concurrence of Finance Department.

xii) Hiring and purchase of new vehicle should be made only with the concurrence of Finance Department

xiii) IT related equipment should be purchased only through GEM

Portal or through CPRCS.

xiv) The rules/procedures related to tender and purchase should be scrupulously followed.

xv) Honorarium should be allowed only as per the rate fixed by Finance

Department.

xvi) Amount for settling Pending Bills for the previous years should be from the savings and if any additional amount is required, Additional Authorization proposal should be submitted.

xvii) All proposals involving engaging contract manpower shall be

routed through Finance Department.

xviii) The Departments should use common IT Infrastructure available to the maximum possible extent.
